### This week's box:

We have potatoes, sweet corn, tomatoes, peppers, eggplant, cucumbers, turnips, beets, carrots, apples, peaches, onions, garlic, squash, and herbs. When I have too much corn to use I t cut it off the cob and put it in a freezer bag for soup this winter.

I like to make basic apple crisp with the apples. This variety is good for baking. We have three Fuji types to plant once it is time.

I hope you are not throwing out your large cucumber; they are very tasty and make great cucumber sticks. I peel and seed then slice into sticks. Matt can not believe they grow so fast, plus they hide well.

### Farm Report

The pears and pomegranates are getting close. We have a very nice crop. We will have plenty of cauliflower, cabbage, broccoli, lettuces, and arugula.
